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**9 CFR 310.22 RELEVANT REGULATIONS UPDATED IN THE PBIS CITATION LIST**

This notice announces that FSIS has updated the list of regulation citations in the Performance-Based Inspection System (PBIS) to reflect the changes made in 9 CFR 310.22 by the final rule, "Prohibition of the Use of Specified Risk Materials for Human Food and Requirements for the Disposition of Non-Ambulatory Disabled Cattle; Prohibition of the Use of Certain Stunning Devices Used to Immobilize Cattle During Slaughter," which the Agency adopted on 10/1/07.

The amendments to 9 CFR 310.22, *Specified risk materials from cattle and their handling and disposition*, necessitated a change to the list of "Possible Regulations Citation(s)" in the electronic Noncompliance Record in PBIS. The new final rule added a new subsection, 9 CFR 310.22(d), *Requirements for use of small intestine for human food*. The old 9 CFR 310.22(d) became 9 CFR 310.22(e), *Procedures for the removal, segregation, and disposition of specified risk materials*. Therefore, FSIS has updated the list of "Possible Regulations Citation(s)" in the electronic Noncompliance Record in PBIS to include all the citations for 9 CFR 310.22(a) through (h).
